Level 3 Award In First Aid At Work (RQF)

Course Overview: The Level 3 First Aid at Work course is an in depth first aid training course designed to enable participants to attain the knowledge and skills needed to become a first aider in their workplace. At the end of the course participants will be able to demonstrate the practical administration of safe, prompt and effective first aid in emergency situations with an understanding of the role of the first aider. The course will also assist employers to fulfil their responsibilities under the Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981 which states all organisations must make arrangements to ensure their employees receive immediate attention if they are injured or taken ill at work. This includes carrying out a risk assessment, appointing a suitable amount of first aiders and providing appropriate first aid training. What's more, as a regulated qualification, employers can book this course for their employees and rest assured that they have fulfilled their legal responsibilities for providing quality first aid training, without having to undertake any lengthy due diligence checks introduced in the recent HSE changes.

Who is this course for? This course is designed for people who have a specific responsibility at work, or in voluntary and community activities, to provide First Aid when dealing with an emergency situation. There are no formal entry requirements but in order to benefit from the course participants should possess reasonable communication skills.
